

GRACE ON THE ASHLEY RE-OPENING GUIDELINES

For the safety of yourself and others, please note the following:

- The use of face coverings is required to enter the building.
- Please enter through the Rear Welcome Center as all other doors will be locked. A greeter will meet you to sign you in.
- Though we will not have childcare, your children are welcome but should remain with you at all times.
- The front foyer will be open for families with children and overflow if needed and the sermon will be live-streamed on the front TVs, as well as online.
- In an effort to maintain proper social distancing of at least 6 feet at all times, the following measures will also be implemented:
 - Once you enter the building, an usher will direct you to a seat in the sanctuary. The sanctuary has also been rearranged to maximize social distancing.
 - Everyone will be dismissed by row when the service is over.
 - ***Please avoid congregating before, during, or after the service inside of the church building.***
- Offering plates will be placed at the rear of the sanctuary if you wish to drop off your offering, rather than via mail or online.

We also encourage you to follow CDC guidelines with a common-sense approach in all areas of your life and community, including church. Therefore, **please stay home if:**

- You are vulnerable to sickness for any reason,
- You have been sick or have shown symptoms of sickness in the last 7 days (e.g. fever, shortness of breath, cough, loss of taste/smell, body aches, headaches, nausea, vomiting, etc.),
- You have been around anyone that has been sick or had such symptoms,
- You have traveled outside of the U.S. or been to a high-risk area in the U.S. in the past 14 days, or
- You have had contact with anyone who has tested positive for COVID-19 in the last 14 days.
