It Interferes with Our Relationship with God

It Gives Satan An Opportunity



LUKE 6:37

... forgive, and you will be forgiven



Ephesians 4:26-27

Be angry and do not sin; do not let the sun go down on your anger, and give no opportunity to the devil.

2 Corinthians

2:10-11

Anyone whom you forgive, I also forgive. Indeed, what I have forgiven, if I have forgiven anything, has been for your sake in the presence of Christ, so that we would not be outwitted by Satan; for we are not ignorant of his designs.



When Should I Forgive?

As Soon As Possible...



LUKE 17:3-4

So watch yourselves. “If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him. If he sins against you seven times in a day, and seven times comes back to you and says, ‘I repent,’ forgive him.”



To replace hostility and separation with peace and friendship.



Don't waste time bothering whether you 'love' your neighbor; act as if you did. As soon as we do this we find one of the great secrets. When you are behaving as if you loved someone, you will presently come to love him.



LUKE 6:38

Give to everyone who begs from you, and from one who takes away your goods do not demand them back.



LUKE 6:35
