## FORM

1. The Lord's Prayer is both a model AND prescriptive.



# The Lord's Prayer

## FORM

2. The Lord's Prayer shows that our prayers will normally be brief and often.

<sup>7</sup>“And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words. <sup>8</sup>Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

Three Petitions

3. Deliverance – “Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil.”

<sup>13</sup>Let no one say when he is tempted, “I am being tempted by God,” for God cannot be tempted with evil, and he himself tempts no one.

<sup>39</sup>“...My Father, if it be possible, let this cup pass from me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as you will.”
